Perfectly proportioned and with every joint seamlessly finished, Katō's absence of hard edges gives it a soft and gentle aura, supplemented by skilfully upholstered back and seat sections whose lines subtly integrate with the show-wood frame.



Flowing around the back of the chair in a horseshoe form, Katō's wide, elliptical arm rail invites the sitter to rest their hands upon it and in turn, feel the chair's natural wood grain texture flowing down the arm.


